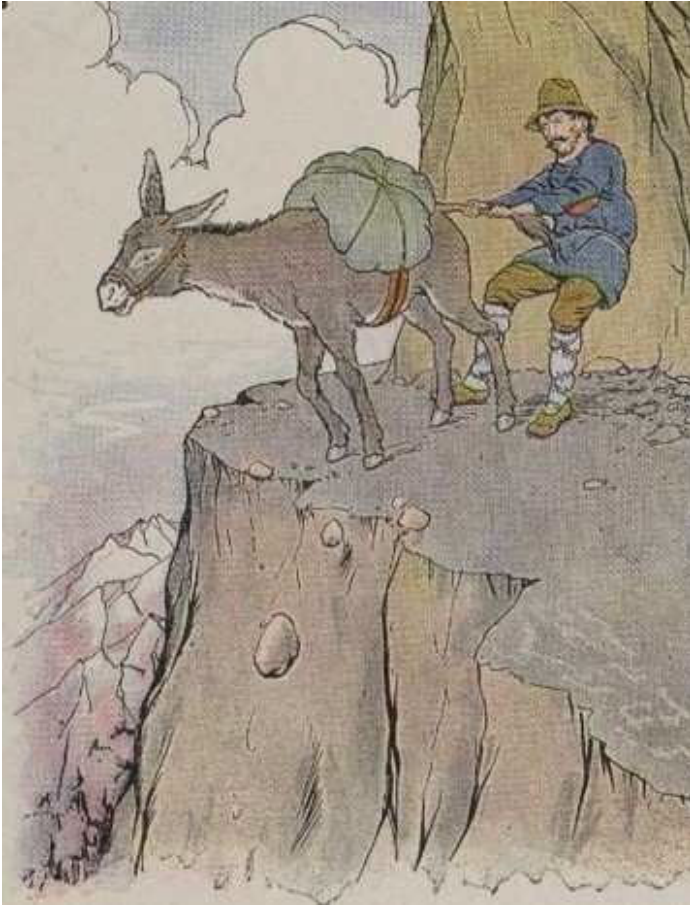


The Donkey and His Driver
